Take a building from the 1950s, remodel it and add a touch of trash... and voila! An authentic urban site for nothing less than lingering is born.

Unconventional, young, authentic, and with a touch of 'trash' were the parameters specified by the sponsor. A budget of under 700 Euro per square meter was available for the project. The locality is located in a no-nonsense, sober building from the 1950s. A room height of just under 3.70 meters was a plus. The existing Odenwald dropped ceiling was removed to expose the cement surface underneath it. That was exactly what lends this space the 'trashy' and unusual character the sponsor was looking for. Clear lines, unified, smooth surfaces and the modern and the antiquated emerged from the exciting contrast between loft and a comfortable atmosphere. A locality was created which shows how life is lived in Nuremberg: with both feet on the ground, and venturesome, tolerant, honest and authentic.
